**To all potential Fulbright U.S. Student Program 2018-19 applicants
(applying thru UW-Madison)**

All candidates must use the electronic application system, which is available through the Fulbright website: <http://us.fulbrightonline.org/>. Click on "Applicants" for instructions on initiating an online application.

Enrolled UW-Madison students must apply for a Fulbright U.S. Student Program award through the UW-Madison's IRIS Awards Office (328 Ingraham Hall) using the Embark application.

Alumni who are not in a graduate program at another institution have the option of applying through the UW-Madison's IRIS Awards Office. If you are interested in doing so, please contact the UW-Madison's Fulbright Program Advisor @ awards@iris.wisc.edu & 608.265.6070. Alumni would sign up for the electronic application through the "Enrolled Student" category.

The Institute of International Education (which manages the Fulbright U.S. Student Program) uses an electronic submission system. All documents that make up the application, including letters of affiliation and recommendation, language evaluations, and transcripts, **MUST be submitted electronically and MUST be submitted by the campus deadline: 11:59am CT, Monday, September 11, 2017.**

Read the **Campus Instructions** for more information about submitting late letters and about having access to the electronic application after the campus deadline, allowing you to revise proposals, provide supplemental documentation, etc.

The only material you will submit directly to the IRIS Awards Office (328 Ingraham Hall, awards@iris.wisc.edu) are Attachments A & B. Attachment A should be submitted by the campus deadline; the deadline to submit Attachment B (interview schedule) is 4:00pm CT, Wednesday, September 6, 2017.

If Attachment B (interview schedule) is not submitted by 4:00pm CT, Wednesday, September 6, 2017 and if an application is not also submitted by the campus deadline, no interview will take place. Under some circumstances, we can accept applications after the campus deadline, but you must contact me to discuss the reason for the late application.

Please read all instructions on the Fulbright US Student program website, <http://us.fulbrightonline.org/> and read the Campus Instructions (available online <http://iris.wisc.edu/funding/students/fulbright-us-student-program/>). You are responsible for submitting a complete and correct application.

The October 6, 2017 5:00pm ET deadline is the final (national) submission deadline. If you are an enrolled student at this university, or an alumnus/a applying through this office, the first required deadline for submission of your application is the campus deadline.
